## **PACIFIC GEM**



#### **BREWING QUALITY**

A high alpha hop with a pleasant aroma and useful bitterness level of 13% alpha. Pacific Gem is very fruity with distinct berryfruit aroma that is prized by many brewers.





### **ORIGIN / HISTORY**

New Zealand origin. A Triploid Alpha type bred from the New Zealand variety "Smoothcone" crossed with Californian Late Cluster x Fuggle. Developed through the hop breeding programme of the New Zealand Horticultural Research Centre known now as HortReseach and released in 1987.

#### **AGRONOMICS**

No real disease problems (New Zealand is hop disease free).

#### **ACID COMPONENTS**

Alpha Acids 11 - 15% w/w Beta Acids 8.2% w/w

Cohumulone 38.5% of alpha acids



#### **OIL COMPONENTS**

Total Oil 1.4 mls/100 grams
Caryophyllene 6.56% of whole oil
Farnesene 0.048% of whole oil
Humulene 17.97% of whole oil
Myrcene 55.35% of total oil
