## **PALISADE**

### **BREWING QUALITY**

Used for its aromatic properties & moderate bittering; has a soft, clean finish with characteristics similar to Willamette. Is used in English-style Pale Ales.





## **ORIGIN / HISTORY**

USA origin. An aroma type cultivar bred by Yakima Chief ranches.

#### **AGRONOMICS**

Low susceptibility to powdery mildew, Podosphaera.

#### **ACID COMPONENTS**

Alpha Acids 5.5 - 9.5% w/w Beta Acids 6.0 - 8.0% w/w

Cohumulone 24 - 29% of alpha acids



## Type T90 Hop Pellets

#### **OIL COMPONENTS**

Total Oil 1.4 – 1.6 mls/100 grams
Caryophyllene 16 - 18% of whole oil
Farnesene 0% of whole oil
Humulene 19 - 22% of whole oil
Myrcene 9 - 10% of whole oil
