SAAZ

BREWING QUALITY

The classical "noble" aroma hop with long and strong traditions. Associated with the renowned Pilsner lager. Is used in Pilsner, Lagers, Belgian-Style Ales, Lambic, sometimes Bitter.





ORIGIN / HISTORY

German origin. German aroma landrace variety selected in the area of the same name.

AGRONOMICS

Good resistance to wilt; average resistance to perenospora and powdery mildew.

ACID COMPONENTS

Alpha Acids 2-5% w/w Beta Acids 3-4.5% w/w

Cohumulone 24 - 28% of alpha acids



OIL COMPONENTS

Total Oil 0.4 - 0.7 mls/100 grams Caryophyllene 10 - 12% of whole oil Farnesene 11 - 15% of whole oil Humulene 40 - 45% of whole oil Myrcene 20 - 25% of whole oil

Possible Substitutions: Tettnang, Lubelski
